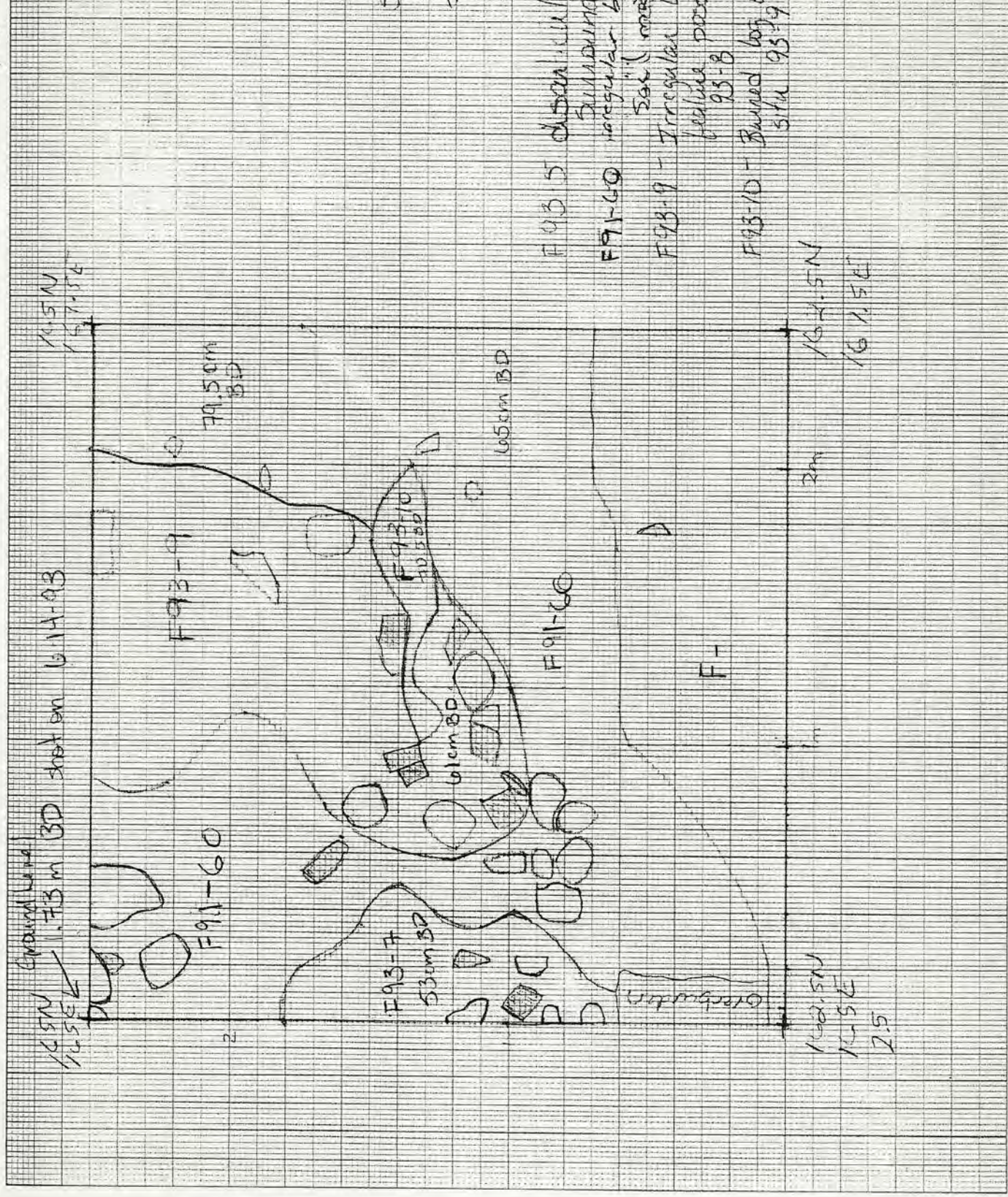

The beam/log also appeared to be hollow, and more of the altered F#93-9 was found in the center; perhaps where it washed in. Several bricks contained within F#91-60 had charred faces where the beam laid on top of them.
