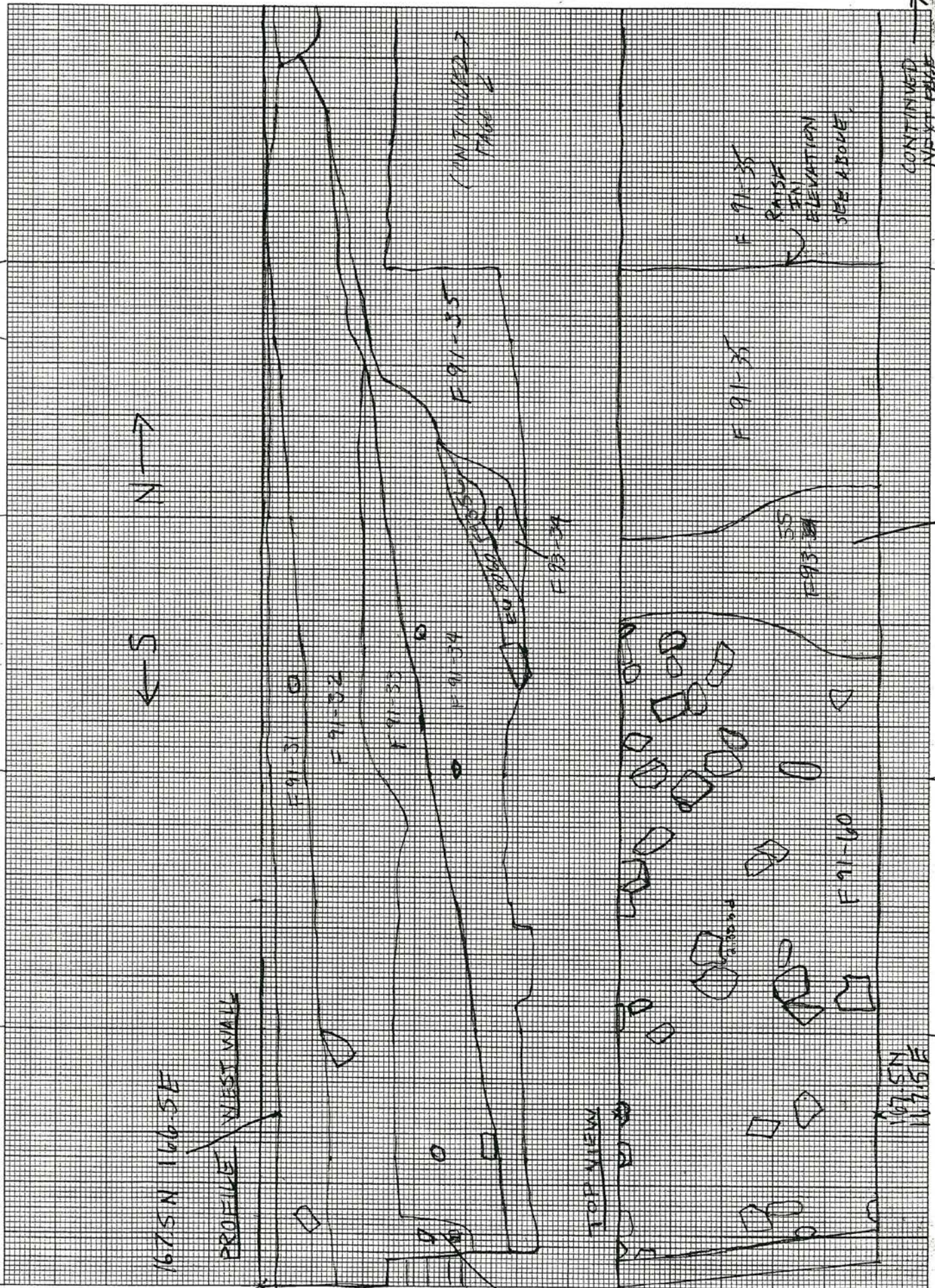

OLD STABLE SURFACE OF FILL OVER 17th CENTURY BUILDING CONTAINED DAMAGED ARMS WHICH INCLUDED BACON WOOD BOARDS AS AN OTHER BUILD UP OF FILL FOR KITCHEN FLOOR.

MAIN FILL OVER 17th CENTURY BUILDING. SANDY YELLOWISH SOIL WITH BRICK FLECKING, ROOFING TILES, OCCASIONAL BONES AND A LOCAL MADE PIPE STEM. OVER FEW LAYS WASH LENSES AND DEBRIS AND IS LIKELY ORIGINAL FILL TO LEVEL SURFACE.

SERIES OF WASH LENSES OVER DESTRUCTION DEBRIS OF 17th CEN. BUILDING. MIXED DARK AND LIGHT LAYERING WITH SOME DEBRIS MIXED IN. SLUMPS OVER "HARRIS HOUSE".

POSSIBLE SUBSOIL. HARD YELLOW CLAY. NO ARTIFACTS.

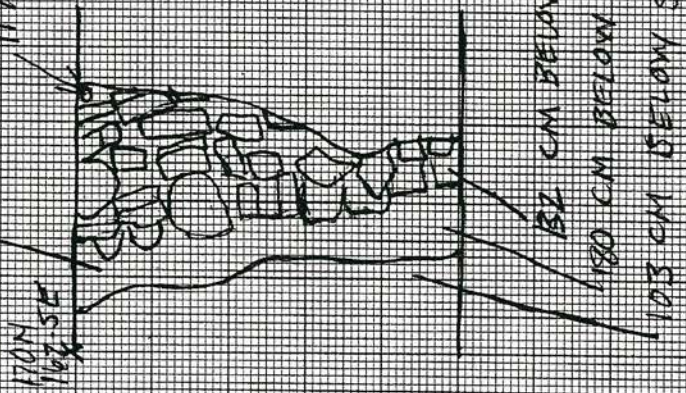

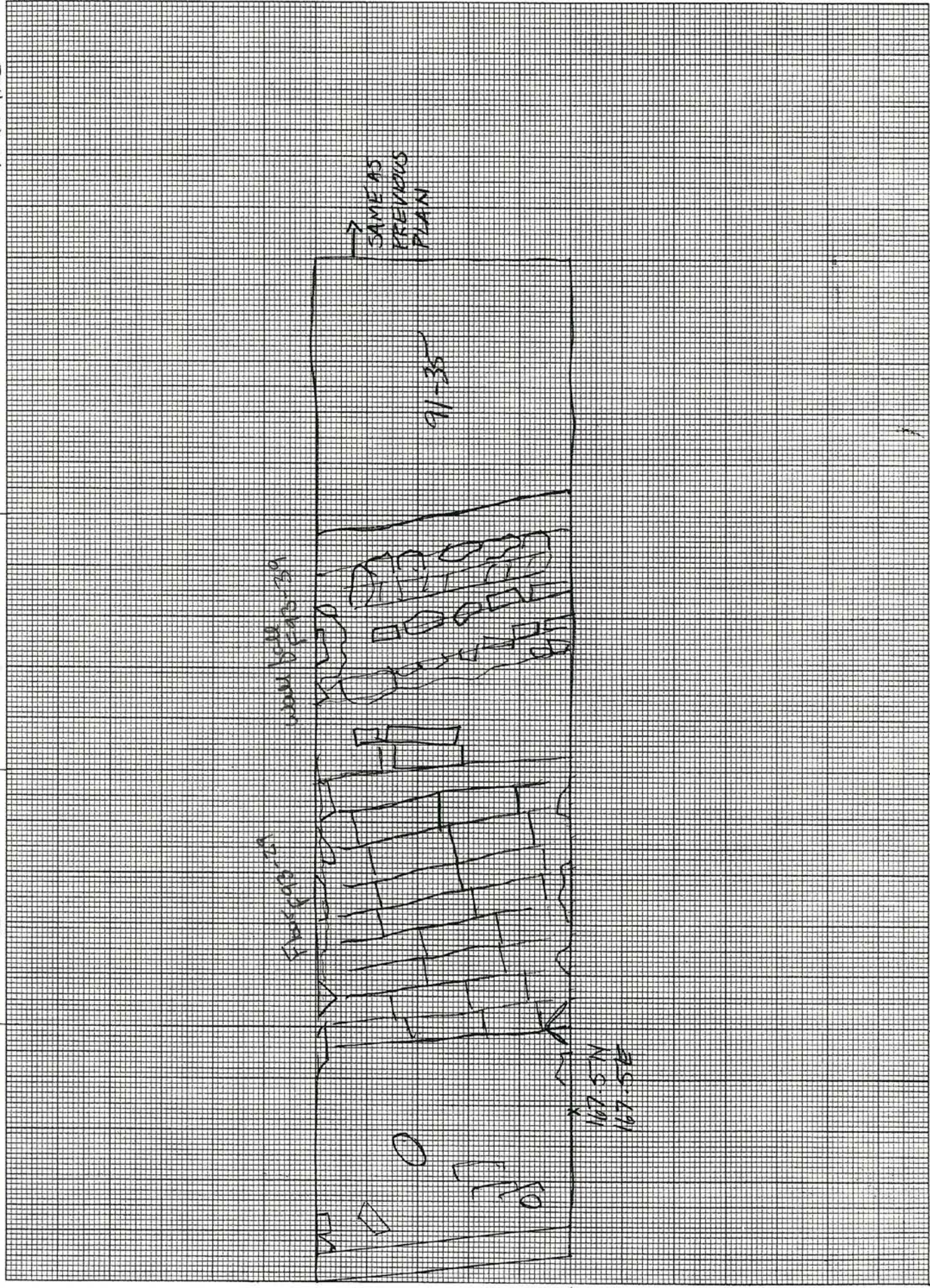

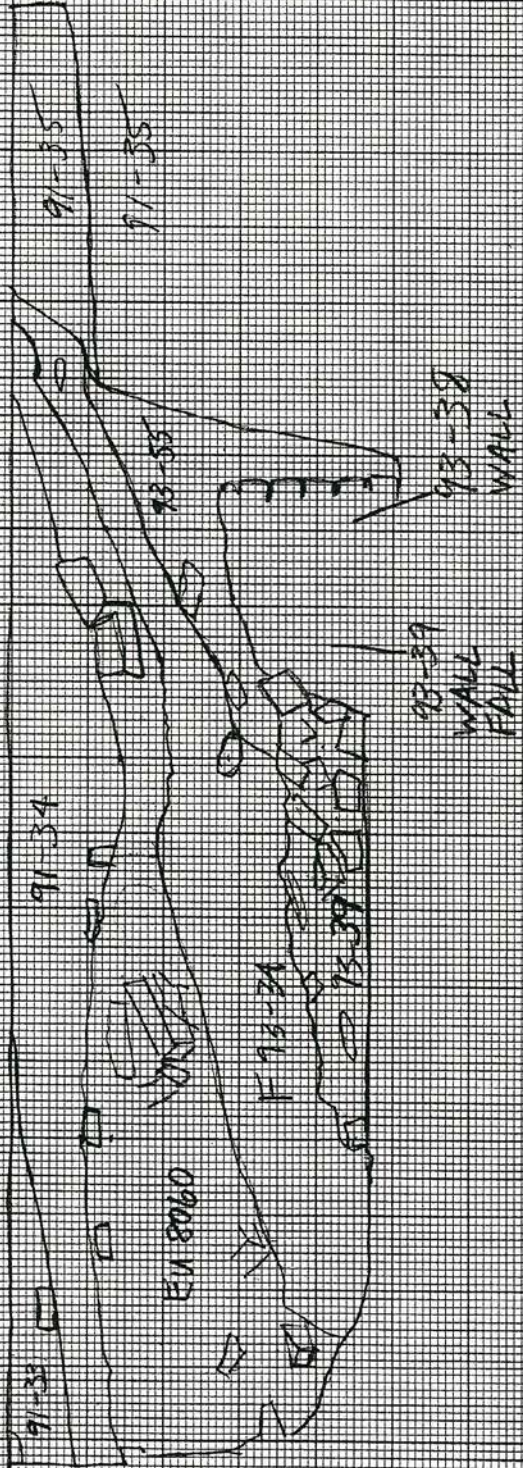

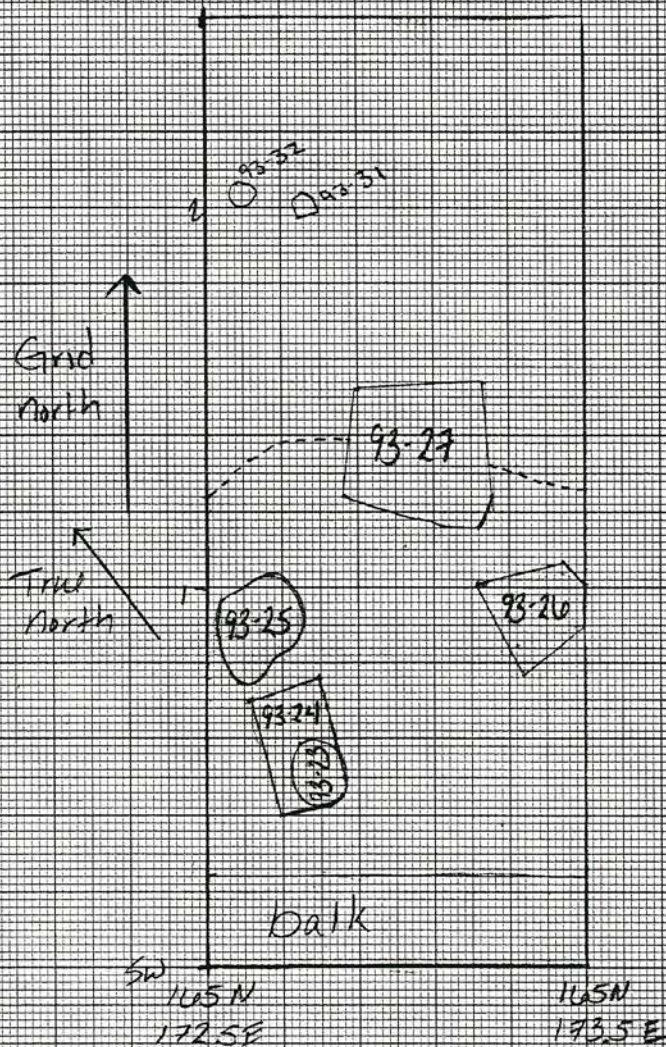
